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Wolfgang Hoffmann is a Professor of Population-based Epidemiology of Health Care and Community Health at the University Medicine Greifswald, Germany. He is also the Managing Director of the Institute for Community Medicine there. Professor Hoffmann is Speaker of the Rostock/Greifswald site of the German Center for Neurodegenerative Diseases e. V. (DZNE). He serves as the Head of the Central Unit of the Clinical Cancer Registry Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania (KR M-V).

Professor Hoffmann is responsible for the central data management of the NAKO Health Study (together with Professor Oliver Stegle, DKFZ) and the German Centre for Cardiovascular Research (DZHK, together with Professor Dagmar Krefting, Göttingen). He is Chair of the Board of the German Network for Health Care Research (DNVF e. V.). He is a member of the Technology, Methods, and Infrastructure for Networked Medical Research (TMF) Executive Board since 2008, and served on the TMF Managing Board from 2011 to 2024. He is a member of the Scientific Advisory Board of the German Medical Association (Bundesärztekammer).

He has been an auxiliary member of the Medicine Committee of the Science and Humanities Council (Wissenschaftsrat, Ausschuss Medizin) for Prevention since 2024.

His research focuses on regional healthcare and innovative interprofessional and intersectoral healthcare concepts, population-based intervention and prevention studies.
