Professor Anita Patel is the Provost's Visiting Professor of Health Economics at Imperial College London and Honorary Professor at Queen Mary University of London. She is an internationally recognised health economist with more than 30 years' experience in generating and applying economic evidence to improve health system design and policy. Her research focuses on public health approaches to prevention, early intervention and long-term care and has influenced national and international strategies in the care of stroke, mental health and many other non-communicable conditions. She has also contributed to international work on frameworks for assessing digital and preventive health innovations. Formerly the Director of Health Economics and Evaluation at Ipsos UK, and as a long-time academic researcher, she has delivered numerous national and international studies for governments, research agencies and public institutions, and continues to advise on value-based health strategy and policy making.
