

## Average Costs for Scientific Personnel

The salary costs are based on the standard tariff classification which must be determined according to the project requirements and the qualification of the co-workers envisaged.

As a rule, the Volkswagen Foundation funds positions for scientific co-workers in projects granted. For Ph.D. students a salary according to a 65 % position is regarded as the minimum. Scholarships are feasible for short research stays and/or in the framework of funding initiatives of the societal transformations team. Scholarships granted in the framework of the Foundation's international funding initiatives are to be awarded in the accordance with the rules in place at the grant recipient.

The following average rates can be consulted as guidance with institutions located in Germany. Social benefits are already included. Additional overheads are not accepted.
