Wolfgang Philipp is the Principal Adviser for health and crisis management at European Commission's Directorate for Health and Food Safety (DG SANTE) since 2026. He was the founding Deputy of the Commission's Health Emergency Preparedness and Response Authority (HERA) in 2021 and worked before as Head of Unit for health preparedness and crisis management, with a focus on EU Member States response coordination, vaccine contracts and joint procurements during the Covid-19 pandemic.

He holds a PhD in microbiology of the Institut Pasteur and University of Paris, France, and continued to work on M. tuberculosis genomics, AMR and pathogenesis at the Universities of Bern and Basel. He was a Scientific Member of the Basel Institute of Immunology (Hoffman La Roche AG), Switzerland, before joining the European Commission in 2001.
