| Transport to the Venue | <p>Herrenhausen Palace can easily be reached by tram. It takes 5 minutes to walk from the main station or the above mentioned hotels to the underground tram stop "Kröpcke". Take Line 4 (Direction "Stöcken") or Line 5 (Direction "Garbsen") and get off at "Herrenhäuser Gärten". The palace is located in the Herrenhausen Gardens.
